The plane took off at 17:22 from Woodhall Spa for a mission on Neustadt, Germany.
At 20:38 it was shot down by a night fighter Obst. Or Hptm. Helmut Lent from the IV/NJG1.
The plane crashed at 4 km East of Urk on section E14 (Kavel E14)

Four crewmembers are buried at the New Eastern Cemetery in Amsterdam.
Mattoon, Trudell en McBurney are found in 1949 and buried on the cemetery of Oud Leusden, Amersfoort.

P.s. This plane was one of two 97 Squadron Lancaster that was lost during this operation, the Lancaster R5497 lost without a trace!
