The Halifax - LW286 was one of two 51 Sqdn Halifaxes lost on this operation. (the other one was HR726)

Halifax Mk.II LW286 LK-H was airborne at 17:04 from Snaith, UK. The cause of loss not established. It crashed at ?02:01? in the IJsselmeer between Urk and Hindeloopen. Sgt. Springett is buried in the Protestant Churchyard in Hindeloopen. F/O Moynihan is buried in Lemsterland (Lemmer) Cemetery while Sgt. Dyer's 1st grave (Grave no. ?) was at Urk till 18-07-1947. Later reinterred at Amersfoort (Oud-Leusden) General Cemetery "Rusthof". The others have not been identified and are commemorated on the Runnymede Memorial
